

Science Fiction Station Chapter 3: The Mootilokygogrifies Find Me Worksheet Part A

<u>Activity 1</u>: In this chapter, Ilnoblet receives a visit from a Mootilokygogrify, and it's not a pleasant experience.

The word 'Mootilokygogrify' is almost like a **tongue-twister** by itself.


Try reading this aloud, very fast:
